School Lunch Cards

Student lunches are \$1.60 and adult are \$2.25 and the price of milk is remaining .30 cents.

We are once again using the lunch cards. They worked out very well last year. So this is just a little reminder of how they work..

Students that have paid get a blue lunch card. A weekly card is \$8.00 (5days) a monthly card is \$32.00 (20 days).

Cards are used until all boxes are punched.

(If it has boxes crossed out that is lunches not paid, such as; if a student paid for only 3 lunches then their card would have 2 boxes crossed out.)

Students that have not paid will receive 5 regular lunches. If no lunch money is paid on the lunch account after they have used all 5 lunches; the student will then receive a brown bag lunch, a peanut butter sandwich and water until their lunch account is caught up-to-date. The brown bag lunches price is the same price as a school lunch.
