Protecting God's Children

Our Parish School will host a safety workshop for adult volunteers on Wednesday, November 6, from 6:30-8:30 PM in the school.

Protecting God's Children is intended to raise awareness of child sexual abuse. Adults who attend the 2 hour session will come away with practical information about the warning signs of child abuse, ways to prevent abuse, strategies for handling suspicions of abuse, and ways to respond.

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph requires all parish and school employees and all volunteers in children's programs (SOR teachers, drivers for field trips, catechists, Youth Ministers, Confirmation leaders, school and childcare volunteers, coaches, chaperones, classroom volunteers, etc.) to take this workshop to help raise awareness about child sexual abuse and create safer environments for all of our children, but all persons interested in making our world safer for children are welcome and encouraged to attend.
