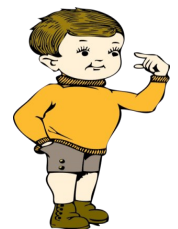
## THANK YOU!

## SOAR Shopping Cards

Did you know that buying SOAR Shopping Cards can help pay for your child's tuition? Each card has a percentage of the sales that we get and now parents can get 50% of that for tuition credit. (example: Golden Corral gives 10%) For \$100 card, the profit is \$10.00. The school would get \$5.00 and the parent would get credit for \$5.00. You can have relatives and friends buy cards and name your family as the benefactors. They can sign up online to place their own orders. The first set of cards will come to our school for someone to pick up. After that, they could reload their cards online! This would work well for out-of-town family members. If you buy your cards at the office or after church, we have a clipboard to designate who you want to receive credit.
